


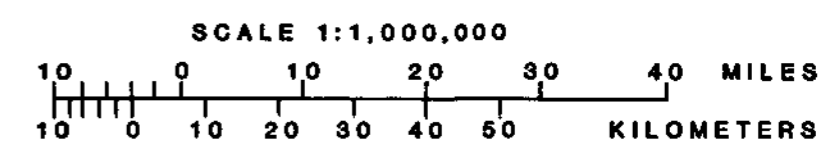
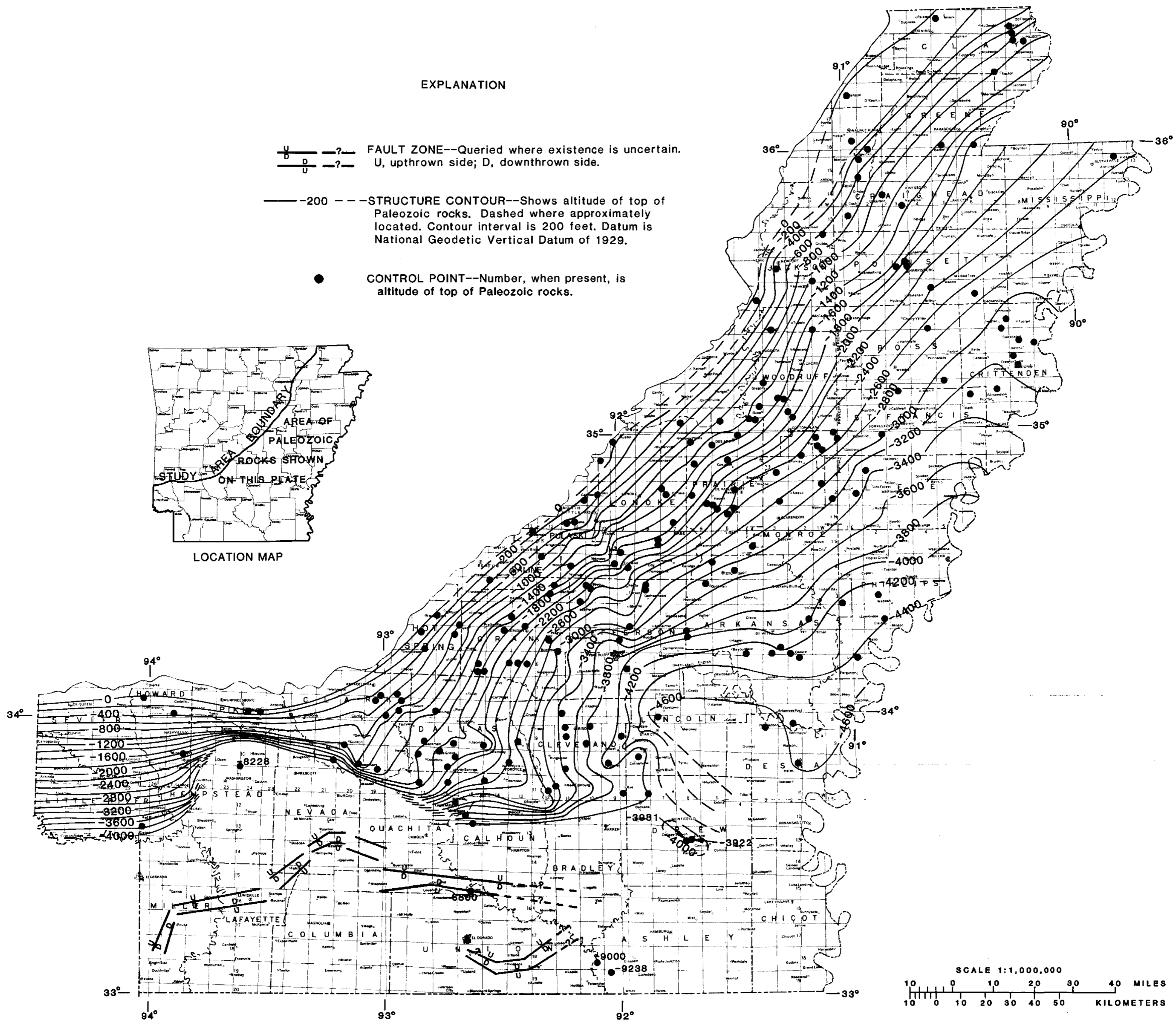


EXPLANATION
